WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Sri E VENKATA SIDDHARTHA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ of Mandamus or any other suitable writ, order, or direction, declaring the action of the Respondents in classifying Survey No., 1147 of Hanamkonda Village and Mandal, Hanumakonda District, as Prohibited Property - Government Land - Gazette No. E2/5229/2002 under Section 22-A of the Registration Act, 1908, as illegal, arbitrary, and unconstitutional and consequently direct the Respondents to delete the said entry from the prohibitory list, permit registration of the Sale Deed executed through Court in E.P. No.116 of 2024.
