Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction declaring the action of the respondents are not paying his due working period salaries though the petitioner is working since his appointment as Grama Palana Officer i.e. from 22-10-2025 to till date, and no single pai of working period salaries were paid by the respondents to the Petitioner, the said action of the respondents is as highly illegal arbitrary, unreasonable, discriminatory and also in violation of principles of natural justice and also in violation of Art. 14, 16 and 21 of the Constitution of India and declaring the same as bad-in-law and consequently direct the respondents to pay his

due working period salaries to the petitioner as Grama Palana Officer from 22-10-2025 to till date.

ORDER:

Heard Sri C.Raja Sekhar Reddy, learned Counsel for the petitioner, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for the respondents and perused the material on record. With their consent, this Writ Petition is taken up for disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that this Writ Petition is filed questioning the action of the respondents in not releasing the salary due to the petitioner from 22.10.2025 till the date of filing of the Writ Petition, while he was working as

Grama Palana Officer, as illegal and arbitrary. In view of the same, learned Counsel for the petitioner requested this Court to allow the Writ Petition by directing the respondents to pay the salary due to the petitioner from 22.10.2025 till the relevant date.

3. On the other hand, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I submits that the respondents will pay the salary due to the petitioner for the period he actually worked, in due course and therefore, requested to pass appropriate orders.

4. In view of the submissions made by both sides, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to pay the salary due to the petitioner for the period from 22.10.2025 to 20.04.2026, within a period of two (2) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, in this Writ Petition, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

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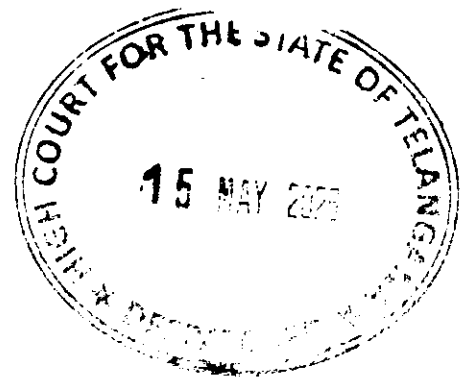
