KADIRE AJITH REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted. ✓

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings of the Petitioner/Accused in Crime No. 11 of 2026 of F.S. Motakondur, Rachakonda, for the offences alleged U/Sec. Sec.329(4), 352, 351(2) BNS.

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Sri V. Raghunath, learned Senior Counsel representing Sri Kadire Ajith Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner has not committed the alleged offences and has been falsely implicated in the present case. The petitioner filed complaint against respondent No.2 on 01.02.2026, basing on which, Crime No.18 of 2026 was registered. Respondent No.2 filed the present complaint as a counter-blast. Even according to the allegations made either in the complaint or in the final report, the ingredients of the offences under Sections 329(4), 352 and 351(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 are not attracted against the petitioner. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioner is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the aforesaid submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner require detailed examination.

Post on 02.07.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused in Crime No.11 of 2026 of Motakondur Police Station, Rachakonda.

In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
