LAKKADI DAYAKER REDDY presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to Quash the FIR.No.509 of 2026, dt.08-04-2026 on the file of P.S. Kukatpally, Medchal Malkajgiri district.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. LAKKADI DAYAKER REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 22.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in FIR.No.509 of 2026 on the file of P.S. Kukatpally, Medchal Malkajgiri district.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed the alleged offence and have been falsely implicated in the present case. Respondent No. 2 voluntarily left the matrimonial house of petitioner No. 1. Petitioner No. 1 filed F.C.O.P. No. 342 of 2023 on the file of the Judge, Family Court-cum-VI Additional District and Sessions Judge, Nellore, seeking dissolution of his marriage. At the instance of respondent No.2, the said F.C.O.P. was transferred to the Court of the Principal Sub Judge, Kancheepuram, and was renumbered as O.P.No.54 of 2025. While the said proceedings were pending, respondent No.2 filed the present complaint by giving it a criminal colour. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint, the ingredients of the offences under Section 85 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 are not attracted

against the petitioners. Hence, continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of the process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 22.06.2026.

There shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 4 in F.I.R.No.509 of 2026 of Kukatpally Police Station, Cyberabad Commissionerate, for a period of eight (8) weeks. In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
