KADIRE AJITH REDDY presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to quash the Criminal Proceedings in Crime.No. 52 of 2026 of PS Women PS, Uppal (Malkajgiri) District, for the offences U/Sec. 85, 115(2), 351(2), R/w 3(5) BNS.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V. RAGHUNATH, counsel representing Sri. KADIRE AJITH REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 02.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings against the Petitioner/Accused No.1 in Crime.No. 52 of 2026 of PS — Women PS, Uppal (Malkajgiri) District, for the offences U/Sec. 85, 115(2), 351(2), R/w 3(5) BNS.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Sri V. Raghunath, learned Senior Counsel representing Sri K. Ajith Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner has not committed the alleged offence and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint, the ingredients of the offences under Sections 85, 115(2), and 351(2) r/w 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 are not attracted against the petitioner. Respondent No. 2 left the matrimonial house of the petitioner ten years ago, and since then, they have been living separately. Therefore, the question of harassing the petitioner for additional dowry does not arise. Respondent No. 2 has filed the present complaint by making omnibus allegations. Hence, continuation of the proceedings against the petitioner is a clear abuse of the process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 02.07.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused No.1 in Crime No.52 of 2026 of Women Police Station, Uppal, Malkajgiri. In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
