Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus to declare the action of the respondent no. 2 to 5 in interfering with the peaceful possession of the petitioner over the schedule property (i.e. land admeasuring Ac 0-08 Gts in Sy No. 2/A/2/AA situated at Jainallipur Village, Mahabubnagar Mandal and District) as illegal, arbitrary and unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondent no. 2 to 5 not to interfere with the peaceful possession of the petitioner over the schedule property and also demolition of the dilapidated building construction over the schedule property (i.e. land admeasuring Ac 0-08 Gts in Sy No. 2/A/2/AA situated at Jainallipur Village, Mahabubnagar Mandal and District)

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to issue Interim direction to the respondent no. 2 to 5 not to interfere with the demolition of the dilapidated building construction over 80 sq. yards in the schedule property (i.e. land admeasuring Ac 0-08 Gts (approximately 80 Sq. yards forming part of larger extent) in Sy No. 2/A/2/AA

situated at Jainallipur Village, Mahabubnagar Mandal and District), pending disposal of WP No 12821 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/S. MADHAVI PRIYA MANTENA Advocate for the Petitioner, GP FOR REVENUE appearing for the Respondents no. 1 and 2 and GP FOR FOREST appearing for the Respondents no. 3 to 5, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Status quo, obtaining as on today, shall be maintained in respect of the building construction in land admeasuring Ac.0.08 guntas (approximately 80 square yards forming part of large extent), in Survey No.2/A/2/AA, situated at Jainallipur Village, Mahabubnagar Mandal and District, until further orders.

This order, however, shall not come in the way of the respondent authorities in taking action against the petitioner by following due process of law.
