No. 99 of 2025 dated 01-06-2025 registered for the offenses under Sections 324 (4), 329 (3) and 3(5) on the file of the SHO, Kataram Village P.S., Kataram Mandal, Jayashankar Bhupalapally DistrictHydg.F.alefacl, Telangana State.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. P.S.D.S. SAI KARTHIK, counsel representing DR P BHASKARA MOHAN Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 02.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 2 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the arrest of the Petitioners herein relating to F.I.R. No. 99 of 2025 dated 01-06-2025 registered for the offenses under Sections 324 (4), 329 (3) and 3(5) on the file of the SHO. Kataram Village P.S., Kataram Mandal, Jayashankar Bhupalapally District.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Mr. P.S.D.S. Sai Karthik, learned counsel representing Dr. Pundla Bhaskara Mohan, learned counsel for the petitioners, submit that the petitioners have not committed any offence and have been falsely implicated by respondent No.2 in the present case. The allegations leveled against the petitioners are purely civil in nature. The petitioners are owners and possessors of the subject land, respondent No.2 is not having any semblance of right or interest over the subject property as mentioned in the complaint. Respondent No.2 himself filed a suit *vide* O.S.No.372 of 2024, before the Senior Civil Judge at Bhupalpalli, seeking declaration of title and consequential injunction in respect of the subject property. When the said comprehensive civil suit is pending before the said Court, respondent No.2 filed the present case by giving it a criminal colour. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds, which were raised by the learned counsel for the petitioners, require detailed examination.

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and seeks further time.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

Till 31.07.2026, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 and 2 in F.I.R.No.99 of 2025 of Kataram Police Station, Kataram Mandal, Jayashankar Bhupalpally District.

In default of filing proof of service by the next date of hearing, the interim stay granted shall stand vacated.
