ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioners seeking to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.3 of 2026 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate First Class Court at Peddapalli.

2. Heard Ms.Gaddala Sharmila, learned counsel for the petitioners and Mr.V.Jithendar Rao, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for respondent No.1.

3. When this Court is not inclined to entertain the criminal petition on the ground that specific allegations are levelled against the petitioners and that the grounds raised in the criminal petition require adjudication by the trial Court, at this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioners has restricted his prayer and requested this Court to

dispense with the appearance of the petitioners in D.V.C.No.3 of 2026 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate First Class Court at Peddapalli.

4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not opposed the submissions made by the learned counsel for petitioners.

5. In view of the above submissions, the presence of the petitioner Nos. 2 to 4 in D.V.C.No.3 of 2026 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate First Class Court at Peddapalli. is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioner Nos.2 to 4 are required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of their non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.

6. Accordingly, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed.
