SRIDEVI KEERTHI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Order / Orders direction more particularly one in the nature of Mandamus, declaring the inaction of Respondent No.4 in rectifying the admitted technical error in the Dharani/revenue records in respect of the petitioner's agricultural lands Admeasuring AC 0.26 Guntas in Sy No 97/2, AC 0.13 Guntas in 97/37 and AC 0.07 Guntas in Sy NO 97/39 of Rama Theertham village, as illegal, arbitrary, violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India and consequently Direct the Respondents to restore the name of the petitioner as pattadar and possessor in all relevant revenue records including Dharani portal and to release all pending Rythu Bandhu benefits and other related benefits along with arrears due to the petitioner.
