Learned Senior Counsel has made arguments in relation to the impugned order dated 18.03.2026 whereby an application (I.A.No.1021 of 2023 in O.S.No.507 of 2016) filed by the plaintiff was allowed with costs by the Trial Court. The plaintiff filed an application under section 65 of The Indian Evidence Act, 1872 (corresponding to section 60 of The Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam, 2023) for leading secondary evidence in respect of 8 documents which form part of the I.A. Senior Counsel has argued that the Trial Court while passing of the impugned order failed to consider or satisfy the requisite conditions stipulated under section 65, specifically clauses (a) and (b) of The Indian Evidence Act, 1872. Senior Counsel does not seek for stay of the further proceedings in the Suit. Considering the submissions made and until disposal of the present Civil Revision Petition, the Trial Court shall hence proceed with
