Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ of Mandamus, or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, declaring the respondents more specifically the first respondent herein not to make any addition, alteration, construction, laying of roads, etc., on or any portion of the property of the petitioner society bearing No. 14-7-95, Muslim Jung Bridge, Hyderabad, admeasuring 4000 sq. yards and consequently direct the respondents to remove and forbid from interfere with the rights of the petitioner society;

IA NO: 1 OF 2021:

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents to consider and place before the court an appropriate scheme rehabilitation of the petitioner society to enable it to carry on its work by giving a land in Begum Bazar or in the vicinity of the city of Hyderabad equivalent to the value of the land acquired/appropriated from its original place in property bearing No 14 - 7 - 95, Muslim Gunk Bridge, Hyderabad, pending disposal of WP 14102 of 2007, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI V HARI HARAN Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri Pasham Krishna Reddy (S.C.) for the Respondent 1 and GP for REVENUE for the Respondent 2, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Registry is directed to print the name of Sri Pasham Krishna Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for GHMC.

Post on 07.06.2021.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to make a representation before the 2nd respondent within a period of two weeks from today, and the 2nd respondent is directed to consider and pass appropriate orders thereon within a period of four weeks thereafter in accordance with law. A copy of the order so passed, shall be communicated to the petitioner.
