Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction and more particularly one in the nature of "Writ of Mandamus" declaring the action of the 1st respondent in issuing Memo.No. 3130/ESTT,-1/2023-2 dt.10.04.2024 and thereby calling for remarks once again despite the said remarks already submitted by the 2nd respondent vide Remarks dt.04.10.2023 and pending with the 1st respondent and set aside the Memo dt.10.04.2024 and consequently direct the 1st respondent to forthwith act upon the Report of the District Collector dt.04.10.2023 and to pass appropriate orders by taking disciplinary action against the 5th respondent;
