WHEREAS the petitioner has presented the Contempt Case under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, through his counsel Sri C.Rajashekar Reddy, praying the High Court to summon the respondents to appear before this Hon'ble Court and punish them suitably for their willful and deliberate disobedience of the orders dated 02-08-2022 in W.P. No.31439 of 2022;

WHEREAS the said case coming on for hearing, and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein, and the earlier order dated 16-06-2023, 26-07-2024 & 27.09.2024, made the following;

ORDER:

This contempt case is filed alleging that there was a willful and deliberate disobedience of orders of this Court, dated 02.08.2022 in W.P.No.31439 of 2022.

The respondents have filed a counter affidavit enclosing thereof a copy of the endorsement, dated 27.09.2024 whereunder the request of the petitioner for compassionate appointment has been considered and it has been rejected only on the



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ground that the CCLA has issued circular instructions not to appoint any new VRAs until further orders, except in extraordinary circumstances with prior approval of CCLA. Further, CCLA has informed that no appointment shall be made in the category of VRAs by any method, including the method of compassionate appointment and directed to reject the representation of the petitioner as there is no such provision of appointments in the amended rules and considering the same, the case of the petitioner for compassionate appointment has been rejected.

Since it is observed in the endorsement dated 27.09.2024, that the petitioner is eligible for a compassionate appointment but is not being considered only because the post of VRA has been abolished, this Court deems it fit and proper to direct the respondent authorities to consider the appointment of the petitioner in any other equivalent post in any other department wherein, the VRAs, have been absorbed, pursuant to the abolition of the post of VRA. Order shall be complied with, within a period of four (4) weeks.
