The presence of the petitioner/accused in C.C.No.600 of 2024 on the file of the Judicial Magistrate of First Class (Juvenile Court), Mulugu, is dispensed with, subject to the condition that he shall be represented through his counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioner/accused is required, he shall appear before the trial Court. In case of non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for his appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
