Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that, although the petitioners have been arrayed as accused in FIR No.73 of 2026, dated 14.04.2026 on the file of Mahankali Police Station, Hyderabad, for offences punishable under Sections 316, 318(4), 351 read with 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), the investigating authorities are mandated to issue notices under Section 35(3) BNS in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of <i>Armesh Kumar vs. State of Bihar</i> [(2014) 8 SCC 273]. 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		undue pressure on the petitioners and interfering with their personal life and liberty without following the due process of law. This matter requires detailed examination and the facts can be ascertained only upon filing written instructions/counter-affidavit by the official respondents. List on 25.06.2026.
