Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ or order/s more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.4 in issuing lookout notice in Crime No.271/2017 and in C.C.No.225 of 2018 and later the same is split up as CC.No.12033 of 2025 as being illegal, arbitrary and violative of Article 19 of Constitution of India and consequently set aside the lookout notice issued by the respondent Nos.3 and 4 in Crime No.271/2017 and in C.C.No.225 of 2018 and later the same is split up as CC.No.12033 of 2025 against the petitioner;

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend the lookout notice issued against the petitioner in Crime No. 271/2017 and in C.C. No.225 of 2018 and later the same is split up as CC. No.12033 of 2025 issued by the respondent Nos.3 and 4, pending disposal of WP No.13405 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Sri V.Venkata Mayur, Advocate for the Petitioner, GP for Home for the Respondent Nos.1 & 3 and Standing Counsel for the Respondent Nos.2 & 6, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Learned Standing counsel appearing for respondents No.2 & 6 submitted that it is the 4th respondent from whom Look Out Circular (LOC) has been originated.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has left the country with the permission of this Court and has drawn the attention of this Court to the order dated 01.04.2026 in Crl.P.No.4653 of 2026 wherein the petitioner was allowed to travel and was directed that on returning to India, he shall deposit his passport before the trial Court. It was also observed that he shall not leave India without prior permission of the trial Court and shall furnish the details of his travel etc., before the trial Court.

In view of the same, respondent No.6 is directed not to arrest the petitioner on his return to India on the date of his origination on 22.06.20296 and arrival on 23.06.2026 at Rajiv Gandhi International Airport, Hyderabad.
