Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to set aside the order passed by the XV Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hyderabad in Crl.Mp.No.6398/2025 in CC.No.9024/2024, dt.09.01.2026 to an extent directing the petitioner to furnish a Bond of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Only) with two sureties and to modify the said condition by directing the petitioner to deposit a reasonable amount as fixed deposit and sureties.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri J. P. Srikanth, Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri Jithender Rao Veeramalla, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No. 1.

The Court made the following: ORDER

Order:

This Criminal Petition has been filed aggrieved by the order passed by the learned XV Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hyderabad (for short, 'the trial Court') in CrI.M.P.No.6398 of 2025 in C.C.No.9024 of 2024, dated 09.01.2026, insofar as directing the petitioner to execute a bond for Rs.2,00,000/- with two sureties.

2. Heard Mr. J.P.Srikanth, learned counsel for the petitioner, and Mr.Jithendar Rao Vccramalla, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of respondent No.1.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an accused in C.C.No.9024 of 2024, for the offences under Sections 498 A, 506 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, 'IPC') on the file of the XV Additional Chief Judicial

Magistrate, Hyderabad, and he filed Crl.M.P.No.6398 of 2025 seeking recalling of NBWs issued against him. The learned trial Court, while allowing the said Crl.M.P.No.6398 of 2025, imposed a condition, directing the petitioner to execute a bond of Rs.2,00,000/- with two sureties. Unless this Court modifies the said condition, the petitioner will be put to great hardship.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submitted that the petitioner is doing a private job and due to his poor condition, he is unable to execute a bond of Rs.2,00,000/-.

5. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that a reasonable amount may be fixed.

6. Having considered the submissions made by the respective parties and upon perusal of the material available on record, it reveals that the learned trial Court, on 09.01.2026, allowed Crl.M.P.No.6398 of 2025 and directed the petitioner to execute a bond of Rs.2,00,000/- and also imposed other conditions.

7. Taking into consideration the peculiar facts and circumstances and the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to execute a bond of Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court. The other conditions imposed by the trial Court shall remain unaltered.

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8. With the above said modification, the criminal petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications, pending if any, shall stand closed.

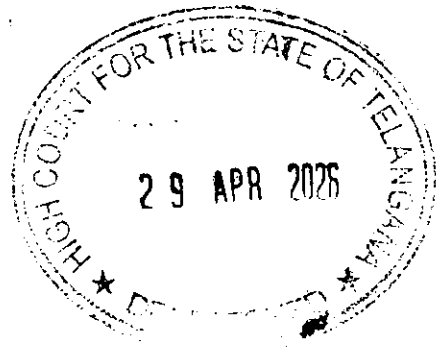
