Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus, declaring the action of respondent authorities, particularly respondents. No. 4 and 5 in interfering into the petitioners and unofficial respondents civil dispute and time and again calling the petitioners to their offices in collusion with the unofficial respondents and threatening to compromise with them as illegal, arbitrary and against the principles of natural justice and in contrary to the law. Consequently, to respondent authorities, particularly respondents. No. 4 and 5 not to interfere into the petitioners and unofficial respondents civil dispute without any valid reason in contrary to law.



I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct respondent authorities, particularly respondents. No. 4 and 5 not to interfere into the petitioners and unofficial respondents civil dispute without any valid reason in contrary to law, pending disposal of WP No 13450 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI CHALAKANI VENKAT YADAV Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR HOME for the Respondent Nos. 1, 3 & 5 and GP FOR REVENUE, for the respondent Nos. 2 & 4, the Court made the following.

ORDER

Notice Before Admission.

Sri M.Srinivas, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 3 and 5 and also seeks time to obtain instructions/file counter, if necessary.

Sri Mahesh, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.2 and 4 and also seeks time to obtain instructions/file counter, if necessary

Issue notice, including personal notice to respondent Nos.6 and 7.

The proof of service to be filed by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the official respondent No.5 at the behest of unofficial respondents is interfering in the *inter se* civil disputes between the petitioner and the unofficial respondents and has been exerting pressure upon the petitioner to settle the *inter se* civil disputes between them.

This matter requires detailed examination and the facts can be ascertained only upon filing written instructions/counter-affidavit by the official respondents.

In the meantime, as an interim measure, respondent No.5 is directed not to interfere in the *inter se* civil disputes between the petitioner and unofficial

respondents, except in accordance with due process of law.
