WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate M/S. RADHA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondent No.3 to 6 in trying to dispossess the petitioners from property in Sy No.49/2Aa , Sy No. 50/Aa, Sy No.49/1Aa an extent of Ac.0.0400c gts, Ac.1.2200c gts, Ac.2.0100c gts, Respectively which is in one compact of Agriculture land, situated at Vaddevata Village, Kothakota Mandal, Wanaparthy District without there being any right over the property to the respondents as being illegal, arbitrary, unjust, improper and is in negation of the established Judicial Precedents besides in violation of Articles 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India apart from in violation of principles of natural justice and fair

play, consequently direct the respondent no. 3 to 6 not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the aforesaid land of the petitioners.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of M/S. RADHA Advocate for the Petitioners and GP FOR REVENUE appearing for the Respondents no. 1 to 4 directed issue of notice to the Respondents no. 5 and 6 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 10.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent No.3 to 6 not interfere with the possession of the petitioners from property of an extent of Ac.0.0400 gts, Ac. 1.2200 gts and Ac.2.0100 gts. in Sy.Nos. 49/2Aa, 50/Aa and 49/1Aa which is in one compact of dry land, situated at Vaddevata Village, Kothakota Mandal, Wanaparthy District without there being any right over the property to the respondents, pending disposal of WP No 12993 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Petitioners are claiming to be pattadars of the subject lands admeasuring Ac.0-0400 guntas, Ac.1.2200 guntas and Ac.2.0100 guntas in Survey Nos.49/2Aa, 50/Aa and 49/1Aa situated at Vaddevata Village, Kothakota Mandal, Wanaparthy District based on Ex.P-1 e-Pass Books No.T04060120121 and T04060121114.

Prima facie, the petitioners appear to be pattadars of the subject land.

Hence, there shall be interim direction to the respondents not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the petitioners over the subject lands without following due process of law.

Issue notice to respondent Nos.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.5 and 6 under speed post with acknowledgement due and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.
