NADIPALLY ANANDA RAO Advocate for the Petitioners, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Notice before admission.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 through speed post with acknowledgment due and file proof of service.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the matter before the trial Court has not been ripe for Trial and is at the stage of summons.

The presence of the petitioners/accused Nos.13 and 14 in C.C.No.254 of 2018 on the file of the II Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Hanamkonda (previous Court of VI Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Warangal), is dispensed with, subject to the condition that they shall be represented through their counsel on each and every date of hearing. If the presence of the petitioners/accused Nos.13 and 14 is required, they shall appear before the trial Court. In case of non-appearance on the specific date fixed by the trial Court for their appearance, the trial Court is entitled to proceed with the matter, in accordance with law.
