WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Ms. SHIREEN SETHNA BARIA presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly a Writ of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ.

(a) Declaring the action of the Respondents 1 to 8 in registering multiple FIRs at different police stations in the state, arising out of the same subject matter / transaction / occurrence, and forming part of a single investigation framework, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 21 and 22 of the Constitution of India and;

(b) Consequently, direct "clubbing" of the subsequent FIRs (FIR No. 62 / 2026) dated 09.03.2026 before Mirchowk PS and FIR No. 86 / 2026 dated 27.03.2026 before Madannapet PS) and, any other FIR not within the knowledge of the Petitioner No. 1 with the Principal FIR (FIR No. 41/2026 dated 10.03.2026 before Rein bazar PS) by mandating a single consolidated investigation in terms of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Ravinder Singh Sidhu v. State of Punjab and T.T. Antony v. State of Kerala.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Puneet Bali, Senior Counsel representing Ms. SHIREEN SETHNA BARIA Advocate for the Petitioners, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos.9 to 11 to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
