AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. E VENKATA SIDDHARTHA Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri P.N.V Maha Lakshmi, Central Government Standing Counsel representing Sri N. Bhujanga Rao, Deputy Solicitor General of India, for the Respondent Nos.2 & 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3 to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

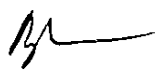
