WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate SRI K SHRIKANTH presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate Writ, Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in calling the petitioner to the police station at the behest of the 3rd respondent and demanding to settle the money transaction with the 3rd respondent, otherwise threatening to implicate him in false criminal case and thereby causing interference in the civil dispute, as being illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the 2nd respondent not to take any coercive steps without due process of Law.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. K SHRIKANTH REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri M Srinivas, ASST GP FOR HOME, for the respondent Nos. 1 & 2, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.3, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 07.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to pass orders directing the 2nd Respondent herein not to call the petitioner to the police station at the behest of 3rd respondent or in any manner interfere in the civil disputes including the personal life and liberty of the petitioner, pending disposal of WP No 13429 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER

Notice Before Admission.

Sri M.Srinivas, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 and also seeks time to obtain instructions/file counter, if necessary.

Issue notice, including personal notice to respondent No.3.

The proof of service to be filed by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the official respondent No.2 at the behest of unofficial respondent No.3 is interfering in the *inter se* private disputes between the petitioner and the unofficial respondent and has been exerting pressure upon the petitioner to settle the *inter se* private disputes between them.

This matter requires detailed examination and the facts can be ascertained only upon filing written instructions/counter-affidavit by the official respondents.

In the meantime, as an interim measure, respondent No.2 is directed not to interfere in the *inter se* private disputes between the petitioner and

unofficial respondent, except in accordance with due process of law.
