Learned Assistant Government Pleaders, representing learned Government Pleaders for Home, Health, Medical and Family Departments, appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 3 and 5 to 7 seek time to obtain instructions, file counters, if necessary and to make submissions. Sri Ramakrishna Kulkarni, learned counsel representing learned standing counsel for respondent No.4 also seeks time. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the case of the petitioner in the present writ petition is similar to that of the petitioner in W.P.No.357 of 2026 and that identical relief may be granted. The learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that without there being registration of any FIR, the respondent Nos.5 to 7 are frequently interfering with the peaceful conduction of the business of the petitioner and especially the 7th respondent is visiting the shop of the petitioner and harassing them. The material on record shows that the petitioner in W.P.No.357 of 2026 was arrayed as an accused in FIR No.2 of 2026 but in the present writ petition, no FIR has been registered against the petitioner herein. In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court is of the opinion that the matter requires detailed examination.
