(a) Issue an appropriate Writ, Order, or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of a WRIT OF CERTIORARI, calling for the records relating to the impugned NALA proceedings bearing No. 2201016617 and No. 2201016614, both dated 25.11.2022, passed by the 4th Respondent, as illegal, arbitrary, without

jurisdiction, violative of art 14 and 300-A of constitution of India, violative of the principles of natural justice and set aside the same and consequently direct the 5th respondent not to entertain any documents the land in Sy. No. 656/14, extent Ac. 15.16 gts, Sy.No. 656/15, extent Ac. 9.20 gts, and Sy. No. 656/16, extent Ac. 10.07 gts, total extent Ac. 35.03 gts, situated at Kandi Village and Mandal, Sangareddy District.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. VENKATARAMANAIAH K Advocate for the Petitioners, GP FOR REVENUE, for the respondent Nos. 1 to 5, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 6 & 7, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to Stay the operation of the impugned NALA proceedings No. 2201016617 and No. 2201016614, both dated 25.11.2022, passed by the 4th respondent, forthwith, pending disposal of WP No 13145 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Issue notice to respondent Nos.6 and 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent Nos.6 and 7 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Learned Government Pleader for Revenue appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 5 shall get instructions by the next date of hearing.

As seen from the record, petitioner Nos.1 and 2 instituted a suit in O.S.No.87 of 2015 in the Court of the Judge, Family Court - cum - VII Additional District and Sessions Judge, Medak at Sangareddy, for declaration and injunction in respect of the subject property, wherein common order dated

24.03.2017 was passed in I.A.Nos.960 and 961 of 2015 directing respondent Nos.6 and 7 herein (defendant Nos.2 and 3) from interfering with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioners and from alienating or creating any charge over the suit schedule property (subject property).

In view of the above, there shall be interim suspension of the NALA orders *vide* proceedings bearing Nos.2201016617 and 2201016614, both dated 25.11.2022, passed by respondent No.4, till the next date of hearing.
