Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the respondent no.3 to 5 are interfering with the peaceful possession of the petitioner patta land in Sy.No. 319/53 an extent of Ac.1.10 gts situated at Janapahad Village, Palakaveedu Mandal, Suryapet District vide Katha No. 814 belongs to the petitioner without following due process of law and without issuing any notice to the petitioner is illegal, arbitrary and violation principles of natural justice and also violation article 14, 19 and 300-A of Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents not to dispossess/interfering from the petitioner agriculture land.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to dispossess/interfering from the petitioner agriculture land Sy.No 319/53 an extent of Ac.1.10 gts situated at Janapahad Village, Palakaveedu Mandal, Suryapet District forthwith, pending disposal of WP No 13290 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI K. VENKATARAMANAIAH Advocate for the Petitioner, SRI L. RAVINDER, AGP FOR REVENUE appearing for the Respondents no. 1 to 4 and AGP FOR HOME appearing for the Respondent no.5, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

The petitioner claims to be the owner and possessor of the land admeasuring Ac.1-10 guntas in Survey No.319/53, situated at Janapahad Village, Palakaveedu Mandal, Suryapet District, on the strength of e-pattadar pass book No.T29190120575 with Khata No.814.

Hence, there shall be interim direction to respondents No.3 and 4 not to interfere with the possession of the petitioner in respect of the subject land without following due process of law.

Mr. L. Ravinder, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue, appearing for respondents No.1 to 4, and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, appearing for respondent No.5, seek time to get instructions.
