Petition under Section 482 of BNSS., praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant the Anticipatory Bail to the petitioner/accused no. 10 in the event of his arrest in Crime No. 628 of 2025, on the file of Pahadisbareef Police Station, registered for the offence punishable under Section 103 R/w Sec 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, and pass such other order(s) as this Court deems fit and proper in the interest of justice.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Syed Jaweed Abbas Nadeem, Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri M. Ramachandra Reddy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and none appears for Respondent No.2.

ORDER

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, who is arrayed as Accused No.10 in Crime No.628 of 2025 before the



Pahadishareef Police Station, registered for the offence punishable under Section 103 of BNS.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the *de facto* complainant lodged a complaint on 14.12.2025 stating that on 13.12.2025, when the younger brother of the *de facto* complainant left out along with his friend, some unknown persons wearing masks by coming on bikes, pushed his younger brother's friend aside and indiscriminately stabbed the younger brother of the *de facto* complainant. As a result, the younger brother of the *de facto* complainant suffered with bleeding injuries and was taken to the hospital. Hence, the *de facto* complainant requested to take necessary action as per law. Based on the said complaint, F.I.R.No.628 of 2025 was registered for the above said offence.

3. Heard Sri Syed Jaweed Abbas Nadeem, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as Sri M. Ramachandra Reddy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent – State.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and is falsely implicated. There is no



material to establish that the petitioner had knowledge of the alleged offence committed by the main accused. The ingredients of the offence of harbouring are not made out. The petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions imposed by this Court. Therefore, he prayed the Court to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner by allowing this Criminal Petition.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the petition stating that the investigation is in progress and if released, the petitioner may influence witnesses or tamper with evidence.

6. Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel on either side and upon perusal of the material available on record, this Court observes that the allegation against the petitioner is limited to harbouring the main accused, the role of the petitioner does not *prima facie* indicate direct involvement in the commission of the principle offence and the question as to whether the petitioner had knowledge of the offence is a matter to be established during trial.

7. In view of the same, this Court is not inclined to grant pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, as sought for. However, the



petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial court and file a regular bail application. Upon filing the same, the trial court is directed to consider and dispose of the same at the earliest.

8. Accordingly, with the above directions, this Criminal Petition is disposed of.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand closed.

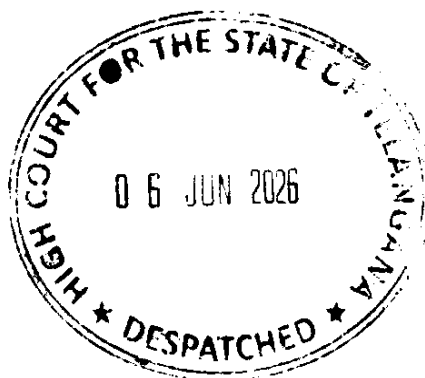
