Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue appropriate Writ, order or direction particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring Senior Professor (Promotion) in all concerned Department in the Osmania University, to the eligible professors inspite of they having sufficient service, qualification, eligibility criteria and good track record and also not acting upon the Report submitted by the Committee and review afresh the Senior Professor Promotion List as illegal, arbitrary and violative of the principals of natural justice, and consequently directing the Respondent No. 3 to act upon the Report submitted by the 3 Men Committee constituted by the Government of Telangana.
