WHEREAS the petitioner has presented the Contempt Case under Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 through its Counsel Smt. N. Sasikala, praying the High Court to punish the Respondent/Contemnor herein for non-compliance and willful disobedience of Orders dt. 22.03.2024 in W.P. 26695 of 2023;

AND WHEREAS the said case coming on for hearing and whereas the High Court, upon perusing the affidavit filed therein, and earlier order of the High Court dated 13.06.2025, made the following

**ORDER:**

**Heard Mr. Vedula Srinivas, learned senior counsel appearing for Smt. N. Sasikala, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Assistant Government Pleader for Assignment.**

**Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Assignment furnished written instructions vide Lr.No.E1/2059/2024 dated 23.04.2026 of the District Collector, Sangareddy District, wherein it is stated that the Tahsildar, Ramachandrapuram, vide Lr.No.B/9313/2016 dated 20.04.2026 called for required documents from the petitioner and based on that, the applications of the petitioner will be verified.**

**Learned senior counsel for the petitioner placed on record letter of the Tahsildar, Ramachandrapuram, vide Lr.No.B/9313/2026 dated 20.04.2026 wherein the petitioner was directed to submit as many as 19 documents, which relate to assignment granted to Ex-Serviceman, the details**

of Ex-Serviceman and other documents. Learned senior counsel submitted that the action of the Tahsildar is contemptuous, as the writ petition was allowed with a positive direction to the respondents to delete the land of the petitioner from the prohibitory list.

The contention of the Government that the land has been assigned to landless poor was considered by this Court and it was held that the land was assigned to Ex-Serviceman under G.O.Ms.No.1460 dated 25.07.1958 (landless poor category) instead of G.O.Ms.No.743 dated 30.04.1963. Thus, the question of the Tahsildar or the District Collector verifying the assignment patta does not arise and more so, when the petitioner is a subsequent purchaser and several hands have changed from the time when the land has been transferred by the original assignee to third parties.

In view of the above and considering that the writ petition, filed seeking for a direction to delete the land from prohibitory list, has been allowed, the action of the Tahsildar in trying to verifying the documents is unwarranted and cannot be sustained.

In the circumstances, Ms. K. Saraswati, Tahsildar, Ramachandrapuram Mandal, Sangareddy District, is *suo motu* impleaded as respondent No.2 in the contempt case.

The respondents No.1 and 2 are directed to forthwith implement the order dated 22.03.2024 passed in WP.No.26695 of 2023 by the next date of hearing. In default, the respondents shall appear before this Court to answer the charges in the contempt case.
