ORDER :

This Contempt Case has been filed by the petitioner to punish the Respondents for wilful disobedience of the Order dated 28.06.2023 of this Court made in W.P. No. 4187 of 2020 in terms of Sections 10 to 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act 1971 and pass such other order as deems fit.

2. Heard Sri Mohd.Sadiq, learned counsel representing on behalf of Rachna Reddy & Associates, learned counsel for the petitioner and Sri R.Sheetal Kumar, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I for respondents.

3. This Court has passed order in W.P.4187 of 2020 on 28.06.2023 as under:

"Accordingly, the respondents are directed to examine the representation, dated 10.02.2020 submitted by the petitioner more particularly in the light of the disability certificate, dated 18.01.2019 issued by the government certifying that the petitioner is suffering from 75% permanent disability and pass appropriate orders within a period of six (6) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order."

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, in compliance with the orders passed by this Court, a speaking order has been communicated to the petitioner by the respondents. Hence, he prays that the contempt case be closed.

5. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services I is present and concurs with the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. In view of the above submissions, this Court is of the opinion that the order passed by this Court has been complied with by the respondents. Therefore, the contempt case is liable to be closed.

7. Accordingly, the Contempt case is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stands closed.

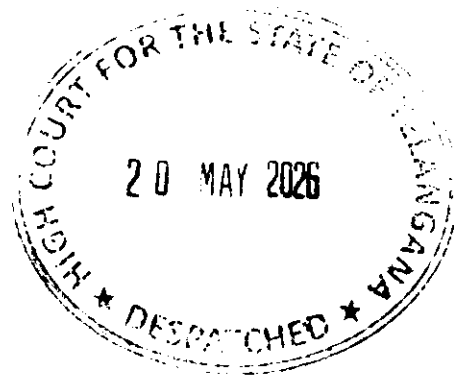
