Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to quash the FIR No 263 of 2026 on the file of Station House Officer, Banjara hills Police Station, Hyderabad as against the Petitioners/Accused No 1 to 9 and 11.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court

may be pleased to stay all further proceedings in FIR No. 263 of 2026 on the file of Stations House Officer, Banjara hills Police Station, Hyderabad, Pending disposal of CRLP No 6749 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. M.S. PRASAD, Senior Counsel representing SRI G PREMGOPAL REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, Additional Public Prosecutor for the Respondent Nos.1 and 2, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

Mr. M.S. Prasad, learned Senior Counsel representing Mr. G. Premgopal Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have not committed any offence and have been falsely implicated in the present case. Petitioner No.2/accused No.11 is a license holder of Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited, and has accordingly entered into the requisite agreement. Accused No.2 has been supplying commercial LPG gas cylinders to customers in Afzalgunj and the adjoining districts in the ordinary course of business. Petitioner Nos.3 to 10 are delivery personnel and drivers engaged for the purpose of transportation and supply of the said cylinders. Petitioner No.1 is the husband of Petitioner No.2. The petitioners have not diverted any commercial LPG cylinders to the black market. Even as per the allegations made in the complaint, the said gas cylinders were found stored in vehicles for the purpose of delivery to customers. The petitioners were involved in any illegal diversion or black marketing of the said cylinders. Thus, the ingredients of the offences under Sections 318(4), 288 and 125 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, Section 7 of The Essential Commodities Act, 1955 and Section 9(B)(1)(b) of the Explosives Act, 1884 are not attracted against the petitioners. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of process of law. Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds, which were raised by the learned counsel for the petitioners, require detailed examination.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 and seeks time for getting instructions and to proceed with the matter.

Post on 29.06.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 9 and 11 in F.I.R.No.263 of 2026 of Banjara Hills Police Station, Hyderabad.
