In view of the reasons assigned in the accompanying affidavit, this application is ordered. <u>JSR,J</u> <u>CrI.P.No.9791 of 2026</u> This criminal petition has been filed by the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 3 seeking to quash the proceedings in F.I.R. No.14 of 2023 of Masab Tank Police Station, Hyderabad, for the offences punishable under Sections 354, 354(a), 498-A, 506, 376 r/w 511 r/w 34 of the IPC. Heard Mr.P.Rana Kamalasan, learned counsel for the petitioners, Mr.Ibad Ur Rehman Khan, learned counsel for respondent No.2/<i>de-facto</i> complainant/victim and Mr.Jithendar Rao, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of respondent No.1-State. 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		Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that petitioner No.1 is brother-in-law of husband of respondent No.2/<i>de-facto</i> complainant, and petitioner Nos.2 and 3 are her husband's brother and sister. He further submitted that due to matrimonial and other disputes pending between them, respondent No.2 lodged the complaint against them. However, at the instance of elders and well wishers, the petitioners, respondent No.2 and her husband were entered into a matrimonial settlement on 10.12.2025. Pursuant to the said Matrimonial Settlement, respondent No.2 intend to obtain KHULA/DIVORCE and the petitioners and her husband want to pay Rs.15 lakhs towards full and final settlement in respect of the pendency of the proceedings between the <i>de-facto</i> complainant and her husband and other family members, especially in DVC No.183 of 2024 on the file of IV Metropolitan Magistrate, Hyderabad and O.P.No.1808 of 2023, on the file of II Additional Family Court, Kalpataru, Hyderabad (presently I Additional Family Court, Kalpataru, Hyderabad) for dissolution of the marriage of respondent No.2 and her husband. When this Court raised a query whether the parties are entitled to seek for recording compromise in heinous offences, learned counsel for respondent No.2 submitted that respondent No.2 specifically stated the reasons for recording the compromise in her sworn affidavit filed along	

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		with I.A.No.3 of 2026, wherein it is stated that due to misunderstandings she lodged the complaint against her husband and other family members by making serious allegations. However, due to the intervention of the elders and well wishers, the parties in the present case entered into a matrimonial settlement on 10.12.2025. By virtue of the said settlement, she does not want to prosecute the proceedings against the petitioners in PRC No.370 of 2025. Accordingly, both the parties have filed I.A.Nos.2 and 3 of 2026 seeking permission to compound the offences and to record the compromise respectively. He further submitted that the parties are ready and willing to appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor has not disputed the above said submissions. Taking into consideration the above said submissions and the principles laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in Madhukar and others vs. State of Maharashtra¹, as well as the averments of the sworn affidavit filed by respondent No.2 in para Nos.3 and 4 in I.A.No.3 of 2026, the petitioners and respondent No.2 are directed to appear before the High Court Legal Services Committee on 17.07.2026 for their identification. In view of the above said submission, the Registry is directed to transmit the case file to the
