Petition under Section 528 of BNSS praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to extend the time limit for a period of further 6 weeks in the order dated 30/04/2026 in CrIp.No. 6793 of 2026 in CrI.M.P.No.766 of 2026 in CrI.Appl.No.139 of 2026 on the file of Special Judge for Trial of Offences under SCs and STs (POA) Act-cum-VI Additional Sessions Judge, Secunderabad.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri Gudi Satyanarayana, Advocate for the Petitioner and Sri Jithender Rao Veeramalla, Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1 and none appeared for the Respondent No.2.

The Court made the following: ORDER

This application has been filed by the petitioner seeking to extend the time limit for a period of six weeks to deposit 10% of the compensation amount as directed by this Court vide order dated 30.04.2026 in CrI.P.No.6793 of 2026 in CrI.M.P.No.766 of 2026 in Criminal Appeal No. 139 of 2026 on the file of Special Judge for trial of Offences under SCs/STs (POA) Act-cum-VI Additional Sessions Judge, Secunderabad.

Ms.K.Swetha, learned counsel, representing Mr.Gudi Satyanarayana Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner could not deposit the amount within the stipulated time as directed by this Court vide order dated 30.04.2026. However, the petitioner deposited the said amount on 14.07.2026. Unless this Court extends time, the petitioner will be put to great hardship.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions and the averments made in the accompanying affidavit, this application is ordered.

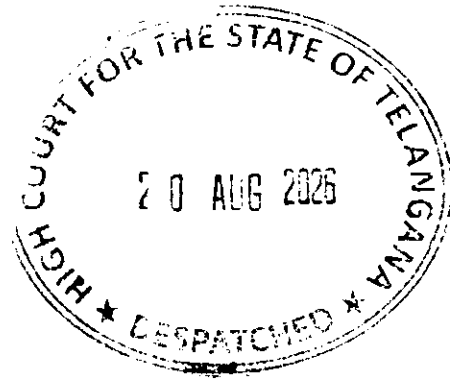
