WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI RAPOLU BHASKAR presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent Nos.5 to 8 in interfering into the peaceful duties of the Petitioner who is working as Anganwadi Teacher in Anganwadi Centre, Thadichettu Thanda Village, Adavidevulapally, Nalgonda District and obstructing not to discharge the duties of the Petitioner is illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14, 15, 21 of Constitution of India and also

violation of principles of Natural Justice and consequently direct the Respondent Nos.5 to 8 not to interfere into the peaceful discharging of duties of the Petitioner as a Anganwadi Teacher in Anganwadi Center at Thadichettu Thanda Village, Adavidevulapally, Nalgonda District and not to threaten the Petitioner that not to attend her duties without issuing any notice and without following the due process of law.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. RAPOLU BHASKAR Advocate for the Petitioner and GP FOR WOMEN DEV CHILD WELFARE for the Respondents, directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
