Upon perusal of the record it reveals that the learned Magistrate, without recording *prima facie* satisfaction and without assigning any reasons, has taken cognizance against the petitioners and issued summons, and the same is contrary to the principles laid down by the Hon'ble Apex Court in *Sunil Bharati Mittal v. Central Bureau of Investigation*¹ and *Fakhruddin Ahmad v. State of Uttaranchal and another*².

In view of the above, issue notice before admission.
