WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate Ms. B KAVITA YADAV presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ of mandamus directing the Respondents No.1 to 3 to set aside the proceedings of Respondent No.3 vide RC.No.B/169/2025 dt. Nil/10.2025 and consequently direct the Respondent No. 3 to issue patta passbooks basing on the judgment and decree passed in O.S.No.9/2014 dt.19.01.2023 on the file of Junior Civil Judge, Mulugu.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Ms. B. KAVITA YADAV Advocate for the Petitioners and GP FOR REVENUE for the Respondents no. 1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondent no.4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 24.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to suspend all further proceedings in pursuance RC.No.B/169/2025 dt. Nil/10.2025 issued by the Respondent No.3 herein and not to make any alterations in revenue records, pending disposal of WP No 14897 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Issue notice to respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 and file proof of service by the next date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that on application of the petitioners for issuance of pattadar pass book in respect of the subject land Ac.0-24 guntas in Survey No.1088 of Mallampally Mandal, Mulugu District, enquiry was conducted by respondent No.3 and report *vide* Rc. No.B/169/2025 dated nil.10.2025 was submitted to respondent No.2 stating that suit in O.S. No.9 of 2014 is pending on the file of the learned Principal Junior Civil Judge, Mulugu (for short 'trial Court') and that third parties are in possession of the subject land. It is submitted that respondent No.3 exceeded his jurisdiction by recording that third parties are in possession of the subject land *vide* registration document Nos.2978 of 2017, 2977 of 2017, 2775 of 2017, 2774 of 2017 and 2773 of 2017. Such finding cannot be recorded by a revenue authority more so when a civil suit is pending and the same is contrary to the decree dated 19.01.2023 passed by the trial Court in O.S. No.9 of 2014 instituted by the petitioners against respondent No.4 and the order dated 08.11.2013 passed in I.A. No.60 of 2013 in

O.S. No.26 of 2009 whereby condone delay application filed by respondent No.4 seeking restoration of the suit in O.S. No.26 of 2009 filed by her was dismissed for default.

In view of the above, there shall be interim suspension of all further proceedings pursuant to the report of respondent No.3 *vide* Rc. No.B/169/2025 dated nil.10.2025 until further orders.
