WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI MOHD YASEEN AYYUBI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondent No.3 in calling the petitioners to the 3rd respondent police station sit in the police station hours together and settle the civil dispute between the petitioner and 4th respondent is illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Article 14, 19 (1) (g) 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondent No.3 not to call to the petitioner to 3rd respondent police forthwith.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI MOHD YASEEN AYYUBI Advocate for the Petitioners and AGP FOR HOME DEPARTMENT for the Respondents no. 1 to 3 directed issue of notice to the Respondent no.4 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home Department takes notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 and waives further notice and seeks time to obtain instructions.

Issue notice to respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 by way of SPAD and file proof of service.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that without registering any crime against the petitioners, respondent No.3 is interfering with the personal life and liberty of the petitioners herein.

This matter required detailed examination and the facts can be determined only upon filing of counter by the official respondents.

In the meantime, as an interim measure, respondent No.3 is directed not to interfere with the personal life and liberty of the petitioners except under due process of law.
