WHEREAS the Petitioners above named through their Advocate SRI Y. SHASHIDHAR REDDY presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue Writ or Order or Direction, more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of Respondent Nos. 6 and 7, more particularly

Respondent No. 7, in harassing the petitioners, repeatedly calling them to the police station, and compelling and threatening them to enter into settlement with Respondent No. 8 and to withdraw the complaint dated 12-04-2026, lodged by the petitioner no.3 against the respondent no.8 and the said coercion is being exerted with an intention to force the petitioners to withdraw the complaint dated 12-04-2026, as well as the subsequent complaints forwarded to Respondent Nos. 3, 4, and 5. and furthermore the petitioners are being threatened that, in the event of their failure to comply with the demands of Respondent No. 8, they would be falsely implicated in criminal cases and taken into illegal custody without following due process of law is illegal, violative of the principles of natural justice and infringe the fundamental rights guaranteed to the petitioners under Articles, 14, 19, 21 and as well as the constitutional right under Article 300A of the Constitution of India and Consequently direct the Respondent Nos. 6 and 7 not to call the petitioners to the police station unnecessarily, not to take any coercive steps against them, not to harass or threaten them at the instance of respondent no.8 and not to interfere by compelling settlement or withdrawal of the complaint dated 12/04/2026.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of SRI Y. SHASHIDHAR REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners and AGP FOR HOME for the Respondents no. 1 to 7 directed issue of notice to the Respondent no.8 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 13.07.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondent Nos. 6 and 7 not to call the petitioners to the police station unnecessarily, not to take any coercive steps against them, not to harass or threaten them at the instance of respondent no.8 and not to interfere by compelling settlement or withdrawal of the complaint dated 12-04-2026, pending disposal of WP No 14882 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The Court made the following

ORDER:

Notice before admission.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home appearing for respondent Nos.1 to 7 seeks time to obtain instructions or to file counter.

Issue notice to respondent No.8.

Personal notice is permitted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at the behest of respondent No.8, respondent Nos.6 and 7 are calling the petitioners to Police Station and exerting pressure upon them to withdraw the complaint dated 12.04.2026 filed against respondent No.8.

This matter requires detailed examination.

In the meantime, as an interim measure, respondent Nos.6 and 7 are directed not to interfere with the personal life and liberty of the petitioners and not to pressurize the petitioners to withdraw the complaint dated 12.04.2026 without following the procedure contemplated under law.
