WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. K JAMALI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the actions of the Respondents more particularly the Respondent No.2 in not returning the EMD (Earnest Money Deposit) amounts to the Petitioner's Firm i.e. (i) Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) vide D.D.No.231073 dt.10-01-2010 as per the said Resolution dt.06-02-2012 ((ii) Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Only) vide D.D.No.690571 dt.22-11-2011 and (iii) debarring the Petitioner from participating in the Tenders vide Letter dt.01-03-2019, as being Unjust, Arbitrary and Discriminatory in nature, violative of Articles 14, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India, and consequently may direct the Respondent No.2 to consider the Apology Letters dt.24-04-2023 and 08- 04-2026 submitted by the Petitioner's Firm by allowing the Petitioner to participate in the Tenders, in the Interest of Justice,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. K JAMALI Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri N.Bhujanga Rao, Deputy Solicitor General of India for respondent Nos.1

and 3, Sri K.R.Koteswara Rao, Standing Counsel for Cantonment Board for respondent No.2, directed issue of notice to the Respondents No.2 herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
