Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to pass an order or orders one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS questioning the action of the Respondents No.2 and 3 herein for non-granting of NOC in respect of land in Sy.No.167, admeasuring Ac.4.22 gts., situated at Anthampalli Village, Bhiknoor Mandal, Kamareddy District, vide Pattadar Passbook No.T12020040040, Khata No.75, allotted to Petitioner's father Late Narayana under Freedom Fighters, Domakonda Panchayat Samithi inspite of Petitioner's application for grant of NOC dated 03.02.2025 to the Respondents No.2 and 3, as illegal, arbitrary and gross violation of principles of natural justice and to consequently direct the Respondents No.2 and 3 to grant NOC to the Petitioner herein in respect of land in Sy.No.167, admeasuring Ac.4.22 gts., situated at Anthampalli Village, Bhiknoor Mandal,

Kamareddy District, vide Pattadar Passbook No.T12020040040, Khata No.75 in the interest of justice.

Heard Mr. K. Buchi Babu, learned counsel for the petitioner,
and Mr. R. Snehita Reddy, learned Assistant Government Pleader
for Revenue, appearing for respondents.

2. It is stated that originally, father of petitioner, late Mr. Kurri Narayana, was allotted Acs.5-18 guntas in Survey No.168/2 and Acs.4-22 guntas in Survey No.167, total admeasuring Acs.10-00 guntas situated at Anthampalli Village, Bhiknoor Mandal,

Kamareddy District, under freedom fighter category in the year 1974-75 *vide* proceedings No.A4/5214/65 dated 12.04.1966. The name of father of petitioner was mutated in revenue records and after his death, name of mother of petitioner was mutated in revenue records. Thereafter, the name of petitioner is mutated in revenue records in respect of land admeasuring Acs.4-22 guntas in Survey No.167 and he was issued pattadar passbook bearing No.T12020040040 with Khata No.75. Petitioner and his family members have been continuous possession of the subject land since 50 years.

3. It is submitted that petitioner submitted representation dated 03.02.2025 to respondent No.2 seeking No Objection Certificate for alienating the subject land allotted to him under freedom fighter category. It is further submitted that Government issued G.O. Ms.No.279 Revenue (Assn.I) Department dated 04.07.2016 dispensing with NOC for alienating lands assigned to Ex-servicemen, freedom fighters, political sufferers for agricultural purposes, in supersession of orders issued under G.O. Ms.No.307

Revenue (Assn.I) Department dated 06.06.2013. Despite the same, respondent authorities are considering the petitioner's representation, as such, he is constrained to approach this Court.

4. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Assignment submitted that respondent authorities would consider the representation of the petitioner and pass orders in accordance with law.

5. In view of the above, without entering into the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of, directing respondent Nos.2 and 3, as the case may be, to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 03.02.2025 seeking NOC for alienating/sale of land admeasuring Acs.4-22 guntas in Survey No.167 assigned to his father, late Mr. K. Narayana situated at Anthampalli Village, Bhiknoor Mandal, Kamareddy District, under freedom fighters category, and pass orders, in accordance with law, by affording opportunity of hearing to him, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. There shall be no order as to costs.

As a sequel thereto, miscellaneous applications, if any,
pending in the writ petition stand closed.

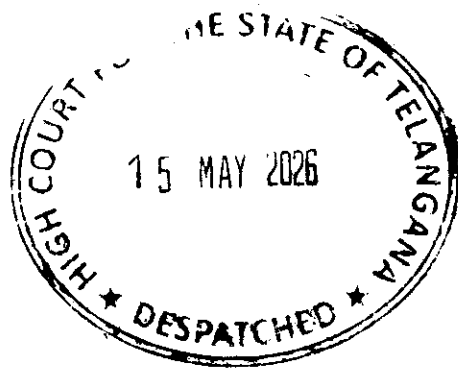
