Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus to declare the inaction of the Respondent No2 and 3 in considering the Representation dated 27/10/2025 and Representations dated 22/09/2025 & 21/10/2025 respectively for providing Compassionate Appointment Pension Gratuity insurance and other benefits on account of death of her husband I Srinivas died on 15/08/2025 who was working as Deputy Tahasildhar as such the in-action is illegal arbitrary and unconstitutional and consequentially direct the Respondent No2 and 3 to provide Compassionate Appointment death benefits such as Pension Insurance Gratuity and others forthwith as expeditiously as possible.

ORDER:

Heard Sri N.Lokesh Varma, learned Counsel for the petitioner, learned Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for the respondents and perused the material on record. With their consent, this Writ Petition is disposed of at the stage of admission itself.

2. Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that this Writ Petition is filed seeking to declare the action of the respondents in not considering the representations of the petitioner dated 22.09.2025 and 21.10.2025, for

compassionate appointment, pension, gratuity, insurance and other benefits on account of the death of her husband, who worked as Deputy Tahsildar and not passing any orders thereon, as illegal and arbitrary. In view of the same, learned Counsel for the petitioner requested this Court to allow the Writ Petition by directing the respondent authorities to consider the said representations made by the petitioner.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Services-I appearing for the respondents submits that the respondent authorities will consider the representations of the petitioner dated 22.09.2025 and 21.10.2025 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law and in view of the same, requested this Court to pass appropriate orders.

4. In view of the submissions made by both sides, without going into the merits of the case, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondent authorities to consider the representations of the petitioner dated 22.09.2025 and 21.10.2025 and pass appropriate orders thereon in accordance with law, within a period of twelve (12) weeks

from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner.

5. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Writ Petition shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

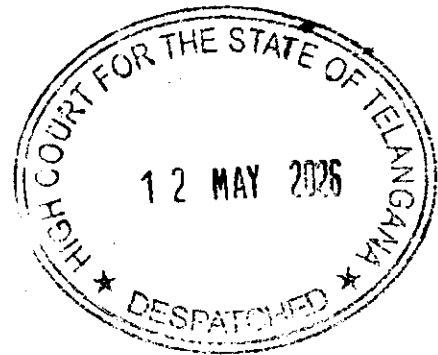
