WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through their Advocate SRI VENKATA RAGHU MANNEPALLI presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents No. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 8 in not protecting the property of the Senior Citizen land to an extent of 266.66 Square Yards in Plot No.41, in Sy.No.43/B, Situated at Kandlakoya Village under Gundla Pochampalli Municipality, Medchal Mandal, District Medchal Malkajgiri, Telangana State as illegal, arbitrary and in violation of Principles of Natural Justice and in violation of Articles 14, 16, 19, 21 and 300-A of the Constitution of India. consequently direct the respondent No.1, 2, 3, 4 and 8 to protect the property of the Senior Citizen i.e. land and House to an extent of 266.66 Square Yards in Plot No.41, in Sy.No.43/B, Situated at Kandlakoya Village under Gundla Pochampalli Municipality, Medchal Mandal, District Medchal Malkajgiri, Telangana State by continuing the names of the petitioners No. 1 and 2 herein as owners of the above said land and house covered in Sy.No. 43/B, Plot No. 41, to an extent of 266.66 Square Yards, Situated at Kandlakoya Village under Gundla Pochampalli Municipality, Medchal Mandal, District Medchal Malkajgiri, Telangana State by continuing the Sale Deed document No. 6815 of 2017 dated 27-09-2017 as it is by the respondents No.1, 2, 3, 4 and 8.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri. VENKATA RAGHU MANNEPALLI Advocate for the Petitioner, Government Pleader for Revenue General (Stamps and Registration) for the respondent Nos.1 to 4 & 8 and Government Pleader for Home for respondent No.7, directed issue of notice to the Respondent Nos. 5 & 6, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.
