WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through his Advocate Sri. C RUTHWIK REDDY presented this Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.1263 of 2025 on the file of the I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Karimnagar, Karimnagar district in so far as the petitioner/Accused No.2 is concerned, in the interest of justice.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. C. DAMODAR REDDY, Senior Counsel, representing Sri. C RUTHWIK REDDY Advocate for the Petitioner, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2 herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 05.08.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the memorandum of

grounds filed therewith (copy enclosed) this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

I.A. NO: 1 OF 2026

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay of all further proceedings in C.C.No.1263 of 2025 on the file of the I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Karimnagar, Karimnagar district pending disposal of the above Criminal Petition.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 by way of Speed Post with Acknowledgment Due and file proof of service.

Mr. C. Damodar Reddy, learned Senior Counsel, representing Mr. C. Ruthwik Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner has not committed the alleged offence and has been falsely implicated in the present case. Even according to the allegations levelled in the complaint, the ingredients of the offences under Sections 166, 167, 418, 420, 423, 465, 466, 468, and 471 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 are not attracted against the petitioner. The petitioner, while discharging his official duties as a Tahsildar/MRO, issued mutation proceedings by exercising the powers conferred under the Telangana Rights in Land and Pattadar Pass Books Act, 1971. Aggrieved by the said order, respondent No.2 filed an appeal before the Revenue Divisional Officer at Karimnagar and a revision before the Joint Collector, Karimnagar, and thereafter approached this Court by filing a writ petition. The orders passed by this Court have become final. Subsequently, respondent No.2 filed a suit vide O.S. No. 97 of 2012 on the file of the learned Principal Senior Civil Judge, Karimnagar, seeking declaration of title and

grant of perpetual injunction. The learned trial Court dismissed the said suit on 07.06.2012. Aggrieved by the said judgment, respondent No. 2 approached this Court by filing A.S. No. 1048 of 2017, and this Court dismissed the said appeal, confirming the judgment passed by the learned trial Court. Thereafter, respondent No.2 filed the present complaint after a lapse of more than 24 years, by giving a criminal colour. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioner is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above submissions, this Court is of the view that detailed examination is required for adjudication of the case.

Post on 05.08.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioner/accused No.2 in C.C.No.1263 of 2025 on the file of the learned I Additional Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Karimnagar. In default of filing proof of service, the stay stands vacated.
