Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings in CC No 253 of 2025 on the file of the Principal Judicial Magistrate of First Class Warangal, registered under Sec.3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 r/w. Till then, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/accused Nos.1 to 6 in C.C.No.253 of 2025 on the

file of learned Principal Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Warangal. In default of filing proof of service by the next date of hearing, the interim stay granted shall stand vacated.
