WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate Sri C HANUMANTHA RAO presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased writ or order more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus for the illegal arbitrary unlawful taking possession of 29 guntas and utilised the same by state and authorities without payment of due compensation to petitioner as illegal unlawful and violative of the constitutional provision article of 14, 19, 21 and 300A of constitution the award passed Bearing no. L.A/02/2005. Dt.19.10.2005, Award no :L.A/05/2005 dt.31.10.2005 to the extent of 29 Guntas have to be set aside and directions to state govt and its Authorities to invoke the provisions of right to fair compensation act 2013 to the petitioner's land of 29 guntas in Sy.No. 345 out of 7 acre 20 guntas of Puppalaguda village R.R district and arrange the payment of my land of 29 guntas acquired by the state and its authorities as was taken possession in 2005 by invoking the land acquisition act 2013.
