AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. T. PRADYUMNA KUMAR REDDY, Senior Counsel representing Sri. T S ANIRUDH REDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, and Additional Public Prosecutor, for the Respondent No.1 directed issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the appearance of the petitioners in D.V.C.No. 30 of 2026 on the file of the IV Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Integrated Family Court Complex, Kalapatharu, Hyderabad, pending disposal of the above Criminal petition.

The Court made the following:

ORDER

Mr. T. Pradyumna Kumar Reddy, learned Senior Counsel representing Mr. T.S. Anirudh Reddy, learned counsel for the petitioners, submits that the petitioners have not committed any offence and have been falsely implicated by respondent No.2 in the present case. There is no domestic relationship between petitioners and respondent No.2, especially respondent No.2 is residing at USA and on her behalf, her mother filed D.V.C.No.30 of 2026 on the file of IV Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Integrated Family Court Complex, Kalpatharu, Hyderabad, claiming various reliefs. Even according to the allegations made in the complaint, the ingredients of the offence under Domestic Violence Act, 2005 are not attracted against the petitioners. Hence, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioners is a clear abuse of process of law.

Taking into consideration the above said submissions, this Court is of the view that the grounds, which were raised by the learned counsel for the petitioners, require detailed examination.

Notice before admission.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor takes notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and seeks further time.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.2 as well as to the counsel appearing on their behalf in the Trial Court, by way of speed post with acknowledgment due or any other mode, which is available under law and file proof of service.

Post on 20.07.2026.

Till such time, there shall be an interim stay of all further proceedings against the petitioners/respondent Nos.2 to 4 in D.V.C.No.30 of 2026 on the file of IV Judicial Magistrate of First Class at Integrated Family Court Complex, Kalpatharu, Hyderabad.

In default of filing proof of service by the next date of hearing, the interim stay granted shall stand vacated.
