**ORDER**

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner, who is arrayed as accused No.1 in Crime No.252 of 2026 before the Banjara Hills Police Station, Hyderabad, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 118(1), 115(2) read with 3(5) of BNS.

2. Heard Sri Nyshadham Chandrasekhar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner as well as Sri M. Ramachandra Reddy, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent - State.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has already filed a quash petition before this Court in Crl.P.No.5945 of 2026, and the said matter is presently pending adjudication before the Coordinate Bench of this Court. He further submitted that the petitioner and the *de-facto* complainant have amicably settled the disputes *inter se* and, pursuant thereto, a compromise petition has been proposed to be filed in the said criminal petition seeking quashment of the proceedings and that, in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties and the pendency of Crl.P.No.5945 of 2026 before the Coordinate Bench, the petitioner seeks this Court to pass appropriate orders in this Criminal Petition.

4. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the respondent-State would submit that, in view of the submission made by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been amicably settled

between the petitioner and the *de-facto* complainant and that the parties are intending to file a compromise petition in the pending Crl.P. No.5945 of 2026 before this Court, therefore, he prayed the Court to pass appropriate orders in this Criminal Petition.

5. Having heard the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, this Court finds that the petitioner intends to file the compromise petition in the pending Crl.P.No.5945 of 2026 before the Coordinate Bench of this Court. In view of the said submission, no further adjudication survives in the present Criminal Petition.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition shall stand closed.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall also stand closed.
