WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through her Advocate SRI M A K MUKHEED presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of WRIT OF MANDAMUS declaring the action of the Respondents more particularly Respondent No.2 and 3 not issuing Hall Ticket to the Petitioner for appearing into the upcoming Final Examination of D.Ed 1st year scheduled to be held in the month of June 2026, on the ground of Shortage of Attendance, knowing well that the Petitioner has suffered severe Health problems specifically leg fracture coupled with a major surgical procedure for the removal of her uterus (hysterectomy), as is illegal, arbitrary and violation of principles of natural justice and consequently direct the Respondents No. 2 and 3 to issue Hall Ticket and allow the Petitioner to appear and write the upcoming Final Examination of D.Ed 1st year scheduled to be held in the month of June 2026, for the academic year 2025-2026.

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and affidavit filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Mr. T.Lakshmi Narayana, counsel representing Mr. M.A.K.Mukheed, Advocate for the Petitioner, Mrs. A.Santhosh Kumari, Assistant GP FOR SCHOOL EDUCATION, for the respondent Nos. 1 to 3, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.4, herein to show cause as to why this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

are directed to show cause on or before 08.06.2026 to which date the case stands posted as to why in the circumstances set out in the petition and the affidavit filed therewith (copy enclosed) this WRIT PETITION should not be admitted.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the Respondents No.2 and 3 to issue Hall Ticket and allow the Petitioner to appear and write the upcoming Final Examination of D.Ed 1st year scheduled to be held in the month of June 2026, for the academic year 2025-2026, pending disposal of WP No 15307 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

ORDER

Notice before admission.

Mrs. A.Santhosh Kumari, learned Assistant Government Pleader for School Education takes notice for respondent Nos.1 to 3, waives further notice and seeks time to get instructions.

In view of the above waiver, the Registry is directed not to take out notice to respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is permitted to take out personal notice to respondent No.4 through Speed Post with Acknowledgement Due and file proof of service in the Registry by the next date of hearing.

List this matter on 08.06.2026.

Heard Mr. T.Lakshmi Narayana, learned counsel representing Mr. M.A.K.Mukheed, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mrs. A.Santhosh Kumari, learned Assistant Government Pleader for School Education.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader has furnished a copy of the written instructions and submitted that as per G.O.Ms.No.97, dated 26.10.2002, a minimum of 80% attendance is mandatory and the Director of School Education is the competent authority to grant condonation up to 10%. According to the information provided by respondent No.4, the petitioner's attendance percentage is stated to be 'NIL' and she has not attended the college even for a single day, therefore, the case falls beyond the scope of condonation. Further, respondent No.4 addressed a letter, dated 24.01.2026 to the petitioner informing her that her admission had been cancelled and advising her to contact the office during working hours for any clarification.

In reply, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner's attendance is not NIL and she had attended the college for one month. He further submitted that due to ill-health and a uterus surgery, she was unable to continue attending the college thereafter.

In view of the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on both sides, the petitioner is directed to approach the office of respondent No.4 for any clarification, if required.
