Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue appropriate Writ or any other order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents in interfering with the petitioners' possession and development activity over their properties i.e., All that the piece and parcel of the land admeasuring Acs.11-16 guntas in Sy.No.291, situated at Kongara Khurd (A) village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District belonging to the petitioner No.1 and All that part and parcel land admeasuring Acs.10-01 guntas in Sy.No.292, situated at Kongara Khurd (A) village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District belonging to the petitioner No.2, without following the due process of law as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and violative of article 300-A of the constitution of India.

Petition under Section 151 of C.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the writ petition, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondents not to interfere with the possession and development activity of the petitioners

over their properties i.e., All that the piece and parcel of the land admeasuring Acs.11-16 guntas in Sy.No.291, situated at Kongara Khurd (A) village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District belonging to the petitioner No.1 and All that part and parcel land admeasuring Acs.10-01 guntas in Sy.No.292, situated at Kongara Khurd (A) village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District belonging to the petitioner No.2, pending disposal of WP No 15325 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI VEDULA VENKATARAMANA, SENIOR COUNSEL APPEARING FOR SRI VISHAL KUMAR JAIN Advocate for the Petitioners, AGP FOR REVENUE for the Respondents no. 1, 2, GP FOR HOME for the Respondent nos.3 and 4 and GP FOR FORESTS for the Respondents no. 5, 6 and 7, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

Heard Mr. Vedula Venkataramana, learned Senior Counsel appearing for Mr. Vishal Kumar Jain, learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue seeks time to get instructions.

Learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on oral instructions, submitted that FIR is registered in connection with the subject property and requested time.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that the Occupancy Rights Certificates have been granted to the petitioners *vide* Proceedings No.J/1724/1992 dated 20.01.1994 and Proceedings No.J/2463/1992 dated 15.02.1994 by the Revenue Divisional Officer, Hyderabad, East Division. Thereafter, the petitioners applied for mutation, which have been sanctioned and subsequently, the lands have been converted under NALA proceedings bearing File No.L/2591/2009 dated 14.10.2009 and File No.L/2491/2009 dated 19.10.2011.

Prima facie, the petitioners appear to be in possession of the subject lands.

Hence, there shall be interim direction to the respondent authorities not to interfere with the possession and enjoyment of the petitioners in respect of land admeasuring Ac.11.16 guntas in Sy.No.291, belonging to petitioner No.1 and land admeasuring Ac.10.01 guntas in Sy.No.292, belonging to petitioner No.2, situated at Kongara Khurd (A) village, Maheshwaram Mandal, Ranga Reddy District, without following due process of law.
