Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to quash the proceedings against the Petitioner/Accused No.4 in PRC No.48 of 2026 on the file of Hon'ble I Additional Junior Civil Judge cum XII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate Court at Kukatpally, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, for alleged offences U/s 143, 144 BNSS & Sec.3, 4, 5 of PIT Act, and pass such other order or orders as it deems fit in the facts and circumstances of the case in the interests of justice.

Petition under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the CRIMINAL PETITION, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including the appearance of the petitioner/ Accused No.4 in PRC No.48 of 2026 on the file of Hon'ble I Additional Junior Civil Judge cum XII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate Court at Kukatpally, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, and pass such other order or orders, Pending disposal of CRLP No 7335 of 2026, on the file of the High Court.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of SRI Kothapalli Narasimha Reddy Advocate for the Petitioner, Public Prosecutor for the Respondents, and the Court made the following.

ORDER

This Criminal Petition has been filed seeking to quash the proceedings in P.R.C.No.48 of 2026 on the file of the I Additional Junior Civil Judge-cum-XII Additional Metropolitan Magistrate Court at Kukatpally, Medchal-Malkajgiri District, wherein the petitioner has been arrayed as accused No.4 for the offences punishable under Section 143, 144 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 3, 4, and 5 of the Prevention of Immoral Traffic Act, 1956 (for short 'PITA Act').

According to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner/accused No.4 is the customer, and the ingredients of Sections 3, 4, and 5 of the PITA Act are not attracted against him.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that when a similar issue came up for consideration in Crl.P.No.2767 of 2025 and batch, this Court, while granting interim stay of all proceedings in the subject crime till the disposal of the criminal petitions, referred to place Crl.P.No.2767 of 2025 and batch before the Hon'ble the Chief Justice for consideration and for passing appropriate orders regarding the constitution of a Larger Bench to resolve the issues.

In view of the above submissions, the Registry is directed to post this matter along with Crl.P.No.2767 of 2025 and batch.

There shall be stay of all further proceedings in the subject crime till the disposal of this Criminal Petition.
